

NEW FIRST GRADE STUDENT

A student must be enrolled in school if they are 6 years of age by September 1st.

If you will be enrolling a first-grade student who has not attended another school, the following things will be required for enrollment:

1. A copy of their birth certificate
2. A copy of their yellow Immunization Card-A copy of this will be needed even if your student(s) has one in their cum file at his/her previous school.

Immunization Waiver Information:

On June 30, 2015, Governor Brown signed Senate Bill (SB) 277. SB 277 Changes immunization requirements for children entering child care or school and no longer allows personal believe exemptions for required immunizations.

However, students will no longer be required to have immunizations for entry if they attend:

- A home-based private school or
- An independent study program with no classroom-based instruction (PSP).
Parents or guardians must continue to provide immunization records for these students to their schools, and schools must continue to maintain and report records of immunizations that have been received for these students.

At this time, HSLDA tells us that NCCS can accept a written notice from a parent stating that their child will be/is exempt from immunizations, whether that is all or a named few.

If you are exempting your student(s) from any or all immunizations, please contact the school and I will send you the NCCS Immunization Waiver Form.
